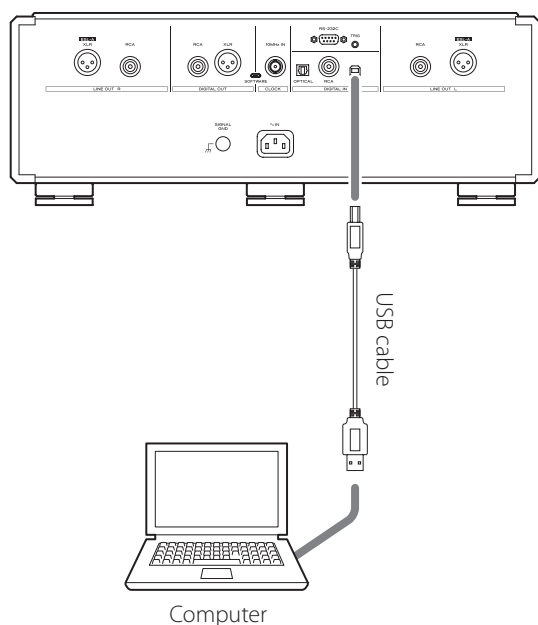
Preparation

A USB cable is necessary to update the firmware.
Use a commercially-available USB cable.

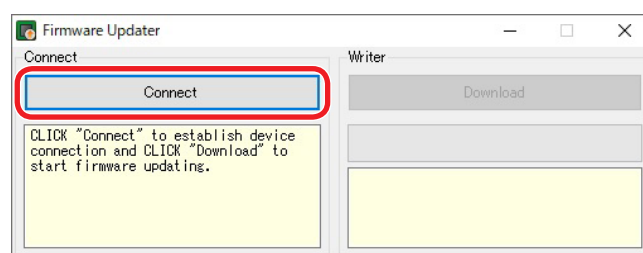
Update the USB/MQA decoder firmware

- 1 Turn the unit on.**
- 2 Set the input source to USB.**
For instructions, see "Changing the input source" in the product owner's manual.
- 3 Connect the unit to the computer using a USB cable.**

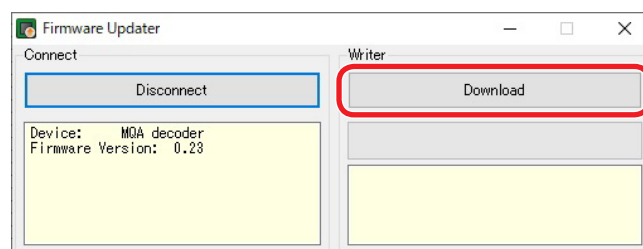
Connection example (K-01XD shown in illustration)



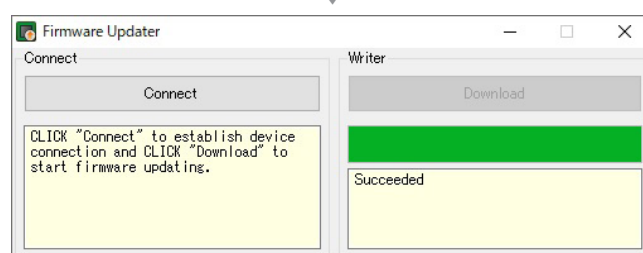
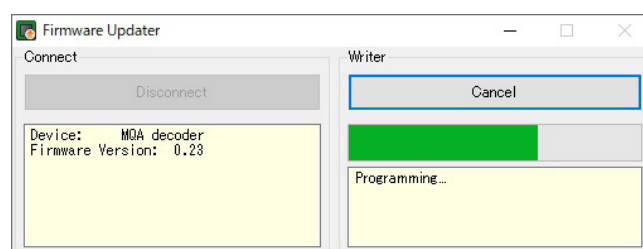
- 4 Double-click USBMQA_vxxxxxx_updater.exe.**
- 5 Click "Connect".**



- 6 Click the "Download" button to start the update.**



- 7 When "Succeeded" appears, press the POWER button on the unit to turn it off. Then, disconnect the USB cable from the unit's USB port.**



- 8 Turn the unit off.**
